## 4th of July at Cable Airport

It is about to get a little crazy at CCB because preparations are in full swing for the for 2023 4th of July celebration produced by the City of Upland and hosted by Cable Airport. This will be the third year in a row that CCB will have hosted this event. As many of you know, Cable Airport has hosted a

variety of events for various organizations over the years because the Airport has always strived to be a good community partner.

The 4th of July event is a major cost to Upland, and it is not an event that is expected to make a profit even though they do charge an entry fee for the experience. Last year's 4th of July event was deemed a huge success. And because of that success, plans are being made to make the 2023 celebration even bigger and better! Upland is planning on expanding the viewing area, increasing the number of vendors, increasing the live entertainment; and increasing the number of attendees.

Unfortunately, more people and more activities lead to both Upland and the Airport having to make changes on how it runs and operates during the event. So, what does this mean for you, our tenant?

Upon multiple planning sessions with City staff, it was determined that trying to segregate the paying public from the airport tenants and their guests was not feasible due to lack of personnel. Therefore, it was determined that all the activities put on by the City would be available to everyone who obtain access to the Airport. This then led to the discussion about airport tenants and their guests.

After pondering the issue, it was determined the Airport had really only two options: close the entire Airport to everyone and only allow those who purchase tickets to attend; or, simply give two free tickets to each leaseholder and require their guests to purchase tickets. Cable Airport has opted for the second option. Based on that decision this is how it is going to work:

### **PRIOR TO 2 PM ON JULY 4TH:**

If you and your guests are on the Airport grounds prior to 2 PM on the July 4th, entry tickets will not be needed.

### **FROM 2 PM UNTIL THE END OF THE EVENT:**

An entry ticket will be needed for each tenant and/or guest wanting to enter the Airport grounds along with your gate card. Tenant access to the Airport grounds will be via the Dewey Way gate **ONLY**.

Each occupant within those vehicles will need an event ticket. Event tickets will be available for purchase through the City of Upland and the Airport Office. Two (2) entry tickets for parking on the Airport grounds after 2 PM will be available to each leaseholder at no cost.

### **THERE WILL BE NO IN-AND-OUT PRIVILEGES. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

The Airport understands that this may be an inconvenience for some; however, this event is an excellent opportunity to show the rest of the community what Cable has to offer if they are not pilots.

### EAA VMC Club Question of the Month – Answer

According to FAR 91.103 (b), For any flight, runway lengths at airports of intended use and the following takeoff and landing distance information:

1) For civil aircraft for which an approved Airplane or Rotorcraft Flight Manual containing takeoff and landing distance data is required, the takeoff and landing distance data contained therein; and

2) For civil aircraft other than those specified in paragraph (b)(1) of this section, other reliable information appropriate to the aircraft relating to aircraft performance under expected values of airport elevation and runway slope, aircraft gross weight, and wind and temperature.

Note that for flights under IFR or a flight not in the vicinity of an airport, the pilot must also obtain weather reports and forecasts, fuel requirements, alternatives available if the planned flight cannot be completed, and any known traffic delays.

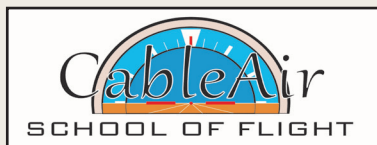
