You are making a daytime VFR flight from Hyannis, MA, to Martha's Vineyard, MA, as shown below. Conditions include a 1,000-foot overcast and 10-mile visibility. What is the highest altitude at which you can legally fly this trip under these stipulated conditions?

Question of the Month – Answer

You must remain below 700 feet MSL – the ceiling of the class G airspace where you can legally fly, remaining clear of clouds. Above this, you enter the class E airspace and must remain 500 feet below the clouds.
