



## Runway 24's Vertical Approach Slope Indicators (VASI) are back on!

After being out of commission for almost three years, Cable Airport's Runway 24 VASI has been turned back on!

The wait came from a variety of factors from having to get a new VASI box built and installed, to having special baffling put inside the boxes that would keep pilots that are turning final too far north of the Runway 24 centerline from being able to see the VASI until they were more aligned with the centerline, to waiting for the FAA to flight check the VASI to test its angles.

The final steps were completed the week of June 19th. After the FAA flight check, CCB was initially told that the special baffling inside the VASI box didn't meet the specifications it should have; however, after the FAA reviewed the data, they discovered the errors were minor and within the FAA tolerances so they asked if we wanted them to correct the baffling or go with how it is. After envisioning another 2-3 year wait, CCB said "Turn it on!"

#### EAA VMC Club Question of the Month - Answer

The numerals described are the Maximum Elevation Figures (MEFs) printed on sectional charts. The Maximum Elevation Figure (MEF) represents the highest elevation within a quadrant, including terrain and

other vertical obstacles (towers, trees, etc.). A quadrant on a sectional chart is the area bounded by ticked lines dividing every 30 minutes of latitude and every 30 minutes of longitude. MEF figures are rounded up to the nearest 100-foot value, and the last two digits of the number are not shown.



### Seen at CCB:

During the early evening of Friday, June 16, 2023, CCB received a visit from N3006, a 1946 DC3 owned and operated by the Flying Circus LLC out of the Chino Airport (CNO). While it is not known who the pilot was, we do know that Cable's own Daniel Wotring was in the right seat most likely instructing the pilot.

And based on flight tracking data for that flight, it can be seen that the DC3 had been flying for about 4 hours initially coming from CNO going to Burbank (BUR), then from BUR to Paso Robles (PRB), from PRB to CCB, and then after two landings and takeoffs, it proceeded back to CNO.

When N3006 first arrived, there was only one car in the picnic area and a couple of bystanders on the airport. By the time it left CCB's airspace, the picnic area was full of cars and dozens of people on the airport had come towards the runway to view this beautiful flying machine in action.
