Airport Will Be Closed for Fireworks Display

On Monday, July 4, 2022, Cable Airport will be hosting the City of Upland "Light Up the Night" fireworks display. Unlike last year, this year's event will be made available to the public, for a fee, with the City completely producing and managing the event. As can be seen on the following page, the City will be utilizing the southern portion of Cable Airport.



The City will be responsible for all public ingress/egress into, and out of, the Airport via Benson Avenue and will utilize the areas shown on the following layout for parking. Benson Avenue will be closed to through traffic between Baseline Avenue and 13th Street.

For this evening, CCB is requesting our tenants avoid this area of the Airport between 6:30 pm, when the public will be allowed on the grounds, until roughly 10:30 pm, the time it is estimated that the area will be clear.

AIRPORT TENANT PARKING WILL BE RESTRICTED

With exception of hangars H-I to H-Z (Aerocommander hangars/ Cable Business Park) **ALL vehicle access to the Airport will only be available via Dewey Way.** Hangars H-A to H-H will not have access to their hangars during this period.

All vehicles will need a pass to gain entry on to the airport grounds. The pass will either be your gate card or a guest pass obtained from the Airport Office. All guest passes will be forfeited upon entry on to the Airport grounds and no additional access will be granted.

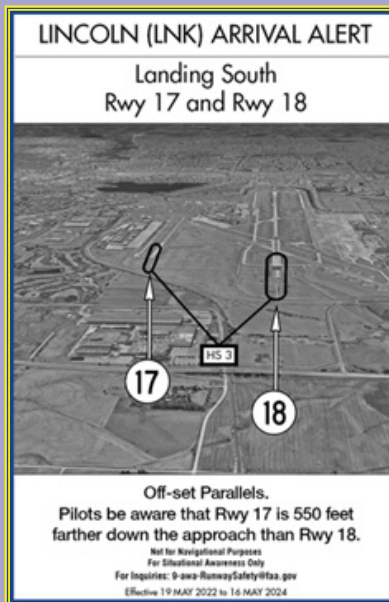

EAA VMC Club Question of the Month – Answer

The FAA is taking several proactive steps to address wrong surface events, reduce the potential for pilot confusion and help improve safety in the National Airspace System (NAS). To manage wrong surface events where an aircraft lines up to or lands on the wrong runway, taxiway, or airport, the FAA releases Arrival Alert Notices (AAN) at several airports with a history of misalignment risk.

Arrival Alert Notices (AAN) are graphics visually depicting the approach to a particular airport with a history of misalignment risk and language describing the misalignment risk. In addition, AANs will incorporate new standardized hot spot symbology as illustrated on the sample AAN above.

The AANs were released in the May 19, 2022 charting cycle. The FAA initially release AANs for 11 airports, including Palm Springs International (KPSP). They will continue to monitor wrong surface events at these locations to determine whether to create additional AANs.

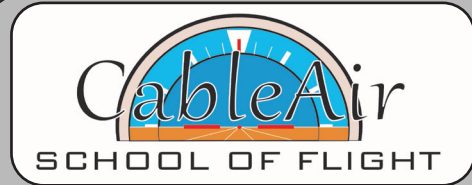

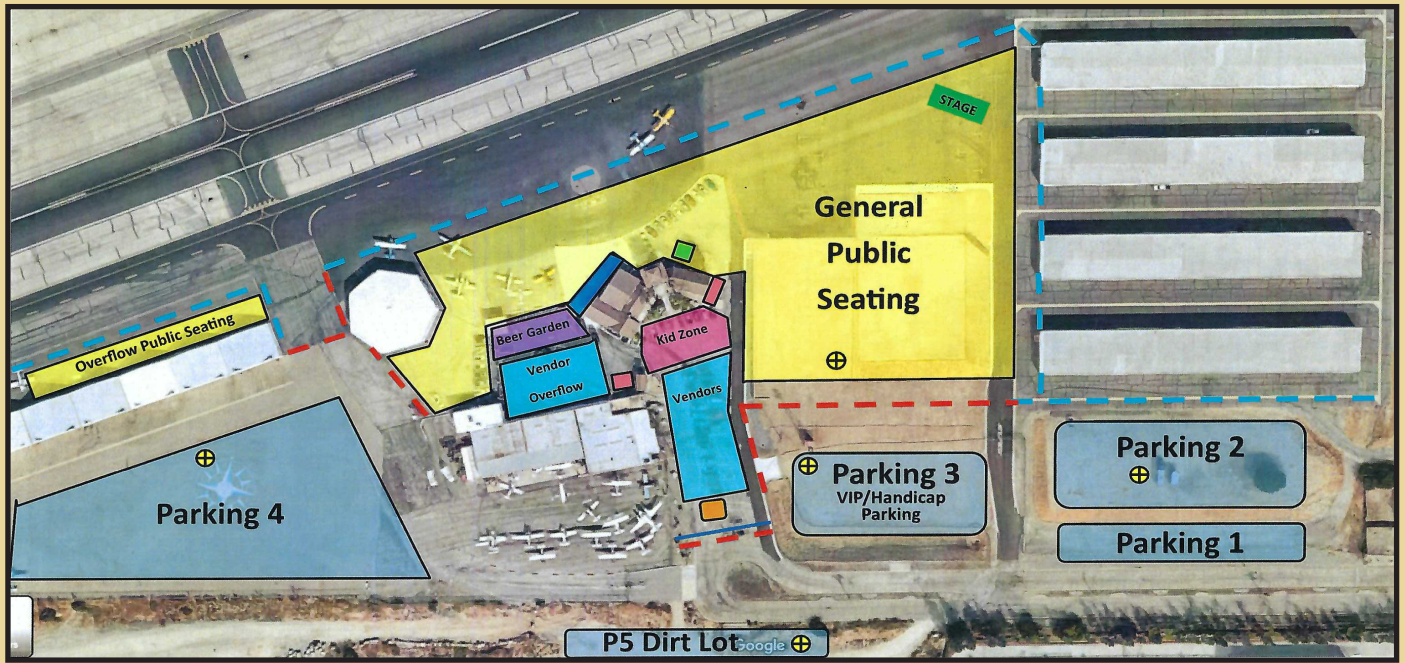
