The City will be responsible for all public ingress/egress into, and out of, the Airport via Benson Avenue and will utilize the areas shown on the following layout for parking. Benson Avenue will be closed to through traffic between Baseline Avenue and 13th Street.

For this evening, CCB is requesting our tenants avoid this area of the Airport between 4:00 pm, when the public will be allowed on the grounds, until roughly 10:30 pm, the time it is estimated that the area will be clear.

### AIRPORT TENANT PARKING WILL BE RESTRICTED

ALL vehicle access to the Airport will only be available via Dewey Way. Hangars H-A to H-H will not have access to their hangars during this period.

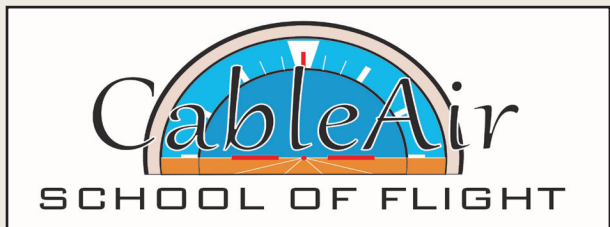
Vehicles will need a pass to gain entry on to the airport grounds for

#### EAA VMC Club Question of the Month – Answer

VOR equipment can be checked for accuracy while in flight by flying over a fix or landmark located on a published radial and noting the indicated radial. Variances of more than 6 degrees from the published radial should be considered out of tolerance and not be used for IFR navigation.
