



Dumping Fee in Effect

Effective March 1st, 2025, there will be a dumping fee of \$25 per dump issued/ billed to your account if you are currently using the dump station for your RV or trailer. As you may or may not be aware Cable is on a septic system and we are not connected directly to any city sewer lines. So, when the tank gets full we need to pay to have it pumped, which is an additional expense for the airport. Often times we have noticed tenants and even tenant friends and family using the facility to dump their trailers which is not the intent to having this amenity. The dumping station will now only be available Monday through Friday during business hours. It will be locked moving forward and if you wish to dump, airport staff will be present to oversee and provide the key for the lock. If you have any questions in regards to this please feel free to contact the airport office.

AUTO PAYMENT UPDATE

We are still in the process of switching auto payment systems. Our current system does not allow us to retain your full information so we are asking that you contact the airport office and provide your current information again so that we can enter it into the new system, and for there to be no interruptions on your account. Several email reminders have been sent out, but if you have not taken the time to respond or contact the airport office, you have until the end of March before your payments will be turned off.

2025 Leases and Hangar Update

So there is a handful of tenants that still need to make sure they return and update their leases but for the most part all tenant leases have been updated. We are also happy to report that we now have FULL hangar occupancy, we are plugging away into the 2025 year with a solid list of active pilots and aircraft housed here at Cable supporting the longevity of the airport as well as the aviation community.

Late Fee Reminder

There has always actually been a provision in your lease that would allow us to implement a late fee for those tenants you who do not pay on time, we just never actually enforced it. As we stated back in the January 2025 issue, we wanted to state again for those you want to claim they were unaware, if rent is not paid within 10 days of its due date, which is the 1st of every month a 10% late fee (base rent based on the rental rates fee schedule) will be charged to the account. One guaranteed way to be sure to avoid any late fees would also be to sign up for auto-pay and you can reach out to us in the Airport office at any time with any questions you may have about enrolling.

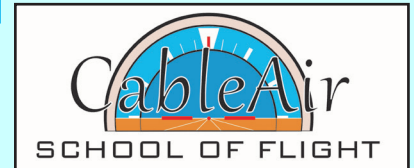

Question of the Month – Answer

No, it is not permissible. According to AC 91.21-1D, paragraph 9.1, Restricting Airborne Cellular Telephone Use, "The FCC prohibits cellular telephone operation while airborne, as noted in Title 47 of the Code of Federal Regulations (47 CFR) part 22, § 22.925. This restriction is valid for all aircraft without technical provisions that enable control of onboard mobile devices to eliminate interference between ground-based cellular stations and airborne cellular devices. If technical provisions are installed, compliant with, or exempt from 47 CFR § 22.925, then usage of cellular-enabled PEDs is acceptable."
