Benjamin recounts, we took off early in the morning and performed a test flight over the field, checking stall speeds before coming back in for a landing. After removing the cowling and completing a thorough inspection, the aircraft was ready to return to the desert and begin the task-based Phase I. It took us about 8 hours of flight time to complete all the tasks.

On Friday, we flew to Big Bear, Thermal, Catalina Island, and Oceanside to get more familiar with the avionics and gain additional practice in the airplane.

I'll continue flying and practicing, and I hope to soon bring my family along so they can also enjoy the beauty of flying in it.

**Question of the Month – Answer**

**Among the factors involved with CFIT accidents are:**

- **Loss of situational awareness**
- **Wire strikes, many of which occur below 200 feet agl, and are not associated with agricultural application**
- **IFR procedural mistakes**
- **Surprisingly, the majority of CFIT accidents occur in day VFR**

**Suggested techniques for avoiding CFIT accidents include:**

- **Using simulators to improve familiarity with approaches**
- **Proficiency training, including the Wings Pilot Proficiency Program**
- **Maintain a minimum of 2,000 feet AGL while in flight**

- July 12/13 Group Sarex

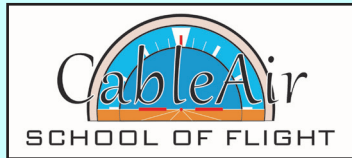


Civil Air Patrol is the Auxiliary of the US. Air Force. We have a variety of missions for both cadets and senior members.
